Subscriptions Reminder

It is the responsibility of **all** club members who attend to help setup the equipment and pack away.

Redruth Archers take part in the Devon and Cornwall Archery Society (DCAS) Indoor Postal League for seniors and juniors – 5 doz arrows

Junior scores are also entered in:

- The Grand Western Archery Society (GWAS) Postal League - 3 doz arrows
- The Grand National Archery Society (GNAS) November Challenge for Juniors - 3 doz arrows

Shooting outdoors still continues during the winter.

The field is available to use 24/7 (except during Tournaments or Have-a-Go's).



If you have any outstanding fees and don't happen to see Paul, you can either drop them through our letterbox or post them. Make sure you put your targets away and leave the buildings and field secure before leaving.

Please remember that ALL Coaches/Club Officials/Committee members are **volunteers**. No-one gets paid for doing the work that needs to be done to keep the Club afloat. So please try and do your bit.
