A timely reminder!!! Redruth Archers will be hosting the World Record Status Double FITA Star Tournament with Devon & Cornwall Archery Society (County) on the 31st July and 1st August 2010.

Income from our tournaments helps to keep your membership fees down. Hosting tournaments also gives archers from other clubs the opportunity to shoot. They have kindly allowed us to compete and achieve our personal goals at their tournaments, so please offer what help you can to make our tournament a success.

Your help is needed: at the work parties leading up to this event and on both days during the tournament in the kitchen and on the field.

Please sign up in the garage. Even if you can just spare a few hours of your time, it will be appreciated.

There will be some archers camping on the field and we will be serving a full breakfast at 7.30 am as well as the traditional bacon rolls and refreshments throughout both days.

Donations are needed for the catering such as pies, quiches, crisps, cakes etc. or perhaps you have some home-grown produce like tomatoes, lettuce or cucumbers you could spare. All catering supplies need to be at the Club House by Friday 30 July, so that I can calculate what I need to buy – thank goodness for 24 hour shopping.

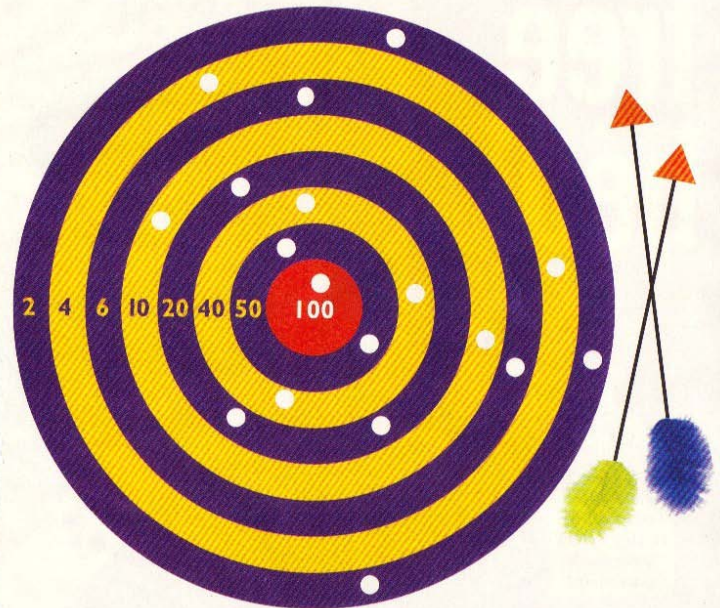

RD CHALLENGE

Good arrows. Robin, Marion and Little John were practising archery in the forest one day. Each fired six shots and each scored 142 points. Robin's first two shots scored 44 points. Marion's first shot scored six points. Who scored a bullseye? The 18 shots are marked on the target.



Answer: Work out the possible scores so that each set equals 142. There are only three ways: $50 + 40 + 40 + 40 + 40 + 2 = 142$; $50 + 40 + 20 + 20 + 20 + 10 + 6 + 4 + 2 = 142$. The first score must be Robin's, as this is the only row in which 44 can be scored in two shots. The third score is Marion's, as this includes a six and we already know that the first score is Robin's. Therefore Maid Marion hit the bullseye.

Our Club Logo is with Trophy Textiles for the front and back of garments. Check that you are wearing the correct colours before you go to a tournament

Redruth Archers Club Colors are registered with GNAS
Club colours are an alternative to GNAS Green or White.

For lower garments is Black
